# OPEN HOUSE AT HISTORIC PLEASANT VIEW AFRICAN-AMERICAN SCHOOL

**VISIT PLEASANT VIEW SCHOOL**, built in 1930 and designated a Chesterfield County Historic Landmark in April 2017 in recognition of its significance as an authentic representation of early twentieth century education in the county. Pleasant View represents the county's rich African-American history; particularly, the county's history of African-American education during segregation.

This treasured landmark stands without any changes to the exterior of the building, original hardwood floors, beaded-board walls and ceilings. The original desks, blackboard and other memorabilia from the past will be on display. **Tours are free** and will be ongoing throughout the day. Parking is available on site.
