CODE OF BEHAVIOR & CAMP RULES

Day Camps offered by the Chesterfield Historical Society of Virginia are meant to be fun and educational as well as safe. To ensure that ALL campers have a good time, yet remain safe and happy, we require that all campers follow certain rules and practice good behavior **at all times**. ALL campers and their parents/guardians must read the following rules TOGETHER. Both will then sign that they understand and will follow the rules at ALL TIMES.

Campers – please read with your Parent!

- All Campers must follow instructions at ALL TIMES as given by assigned staff.
- All Campers must stay with their assigned groups and chaperones at all times.
- All Campers must treat ALL other campers with respect—NO name calling, teasing, or disrespect of other campers or staff.
- All Campers must keep their hands to themselves—NO hitting, pushing, or shoving of other Campers.
- All Campers will respect the Historical Society's buildings, objects, and natural environment at all times. Nothing is to be taken, broken or harmed in any way.

Adults – Failure to follow Camp Rules may result in the following:

- An immediate call by County staff to a parent/guardian regarding the Camper's failure to follow the rules.
- A discussion, at this time, with the parent/guardian regarding the misbehavior and what is expected of the Camper.
- After one warning/talk with the parent/guardian of the camper regarding misbehavior, any further misbehavior may result in IMMEDIATE dismissal of the camper from the camp- WITHOUT REFUND.
- Immediate dismissal from the Camp, the parent/guardian must immediately retrieve the Camper, who will be removed from the other campers and will be in the care of staff management.
